- Swimmers will be on time, do their best, be safety-conscious, and follow pool rules and instruction given by the coaches and CSTC staff – they are there for your safety!
- Swimmers will obey the coach(es) at all times.
- Swimmers will not run around the pool or engage in horseplay during practice.
- Swimmers will respect everyone’s personal property (e.g. towels, clothing, goggles, food, etc.)
- Swimmers will be supportive of all swimmers and will not disrespect anyone within the pool area at any time.
- Swimmers will not engage in unsportsman-like behavior, indiscreet or destructive behavior, or the use of obscene language

I understand that failure to abide by the CSTC Pool Rules and/or Code of Conduct may result in immediate disciplinary action as determined by the CSTC coaching staff or CSTC Board to include but not be limited to removal from practice, or ultimately, removal from the swim conditioning season without refund.
